The Grimaldi Castle Museum

Place du Château – 06800 CAGNES SUR MER

Built in 1309 by Rainier Grimaldi (Lord of Cagnes and an admiral of France) - a distant ancestor of the present ruling house of Monaco.

During the reign of Louis XIII (1610 to 1643) the castle was altered, and the principal rooms made more comfortable and redecorated in the contemporary taste

Today the castle is an exhibition centre for contemporary art from around the world, and a museum of modern art.

Renoir Museum

Chemin des Colettes – 06800 CAGNES SUR MER

The Domaine des Colettes, and its park enhanced by the olive-trees so beloved by the artist, was the last home of Auguste Renoir. Preserved as is with its original furniture and decoration, the house also features: the painters' 2 studios, 11 original paintings from the nacre and Cagnes periods, virtually all his sculpture, some preparatory sketches, lithographs, many old photographs, personal possessions
