Iles de Lérins

L'île Ste Marguerite

The Île Sainte-Marguerite is the largest of the Lérins Islands, about half a mile off shore from the French Riviera town of Cannes. The island is approximately 3km in length (East to West) and 900m across. The island is most famous for its fortress prison (the Fort Royal), in which the so-called Man in the Iron Mask was held in the 17th century. A ferry service runs from Cannes every 20 minutes. Plan a whole day to visit this island.



L'île St Honorat

The Île Saint-Honorat is the second largest of the Lérins Islands, about a mile off shore from the French Riviera town of Cannes. The island is approximately 1.5 kilometers in length (East to West) and 400 meters wide. Since the fifth century, the island has been home to a community of monks.

A ferry service runs from Cannes every hour between 9am and 6pm. Plan a half a day to visit this island.

La Croisette

The Promenade de la Croisette stretches along the shore of the Mediterranean Sea and is about 2 km long. The Croisette is known for the Palais des Festivals et des Congrès, where the Cannes Film Festival is held. Many expensive shops, restaurants, and hotels line the road.



Le Suquet

Le Suquet is the old quarter of Cannes it was the safe home to many monks in 891 when the island had become to dangerous.
